Former NFL players will sign free autographs during the upcoming CASA of Lake County fundraising golf tournament in Polson later this month.

Rocky Klever, who set numerous records as a running back at the University of Montana before being drafted by the New York Jets in the ninth round in 1982 will be joined by Barry Darrow, a First team All-Conference lineman who played five years with the Cleveland Browns starting in 1974.

Klever recently joined the staff of Mike Van Diest at Carroll College while Darrow is a Missoula businessman and former teacher-coach.

Klever and Darrow will join other invited Montana sports celebrities like Wayne Tinkle, Bobby Hauck and Scott Gurnsey to be auctioned off for team play for the April 25 event at Polson Bay Golf Club.

In addition to celebrities like Van Diest, athletic director Bruce Parker, and golf coach Ben MacIntyre, UM athletic department personnel, golf professionals and media, a "Day with the Grizzlies" also will be a live auction item.

"A Day with the Grizzlies" will include exclusive behind-the-scene access to a Griz football game including the pre-game and post-game radio interview with head coach Bobby Hauck, a guided tour of the facilities and participation in Grizzly Scholarship Association activities.
